OTHER NEWS

Learners' graduation:

Last Monday, we celebrated the last of the series of beginner lessons. It was a great pleasure to congratulate twelve new bridge players and hand them their certificates. It has been wonderful to have observed the resilience and determination by this group and we wish them the best of luck on their continued path of bridge learning.



2025 regrading process update:

The annual review of members' grading, according to the 2025 promotion and regrading policy, has been finalised. In the near future, letters of recommendations for promotion to a different grade will be forwarded to those who have met the qualifying criteria.

Regarding the new rule for transitioning to Intermediate grade:

Given the general positive response, we can confirm that the proposed qualifying criteria for promotion to Intermediate grade will be applicable for all members who have played in the Junior grade throughout 2025. The new criteria will be imbedded in the 2026 promotion and regrading policy.

The basic qualifying criteria for a promotion from Junior to Intermediate are:

- The member has played at least 20 Junior grade sessions between 1 January and the end of the first full week of play in October and has been in Junior grade for the entirety of this period.
- The member has played with at least two different partners.

The Junior grade members who meet these two criteria will be offered promotion to the Intermediate grade and they will also receive a letter regarding this promotion. However, if some members wish to keep playing in the Junior grade for a longer period then we encourage these members to appeal the offer in writing to the Match Committee Convenor.



Items for Christmas raffle:

It is time to think about donations for our *mega Christmas raffle*, and any donations will be gratefully received. Please bring them to the Club rooms (or the office) during the week starting 17 November.

Tickets can be purchased starting Monday 1 December at \$5 per ticket.

2026 membership fee:

The full membership fee for 2026 will be \$115 per person. It is an increase of \$10 per person, and this is partly due to forecasted increases in the club's operational costs and partly to the increase in annual NZ Bridge player levy to \$32.20 in 2026 (from \$27.60 in 2025).

In summary, the 2026 membership fees are:

- Full Membership: \$115 (\$82.80 membership fee and \$32.20 NZ Bridge levy)
- Associate Membership: \$82.80 (NZ Bridge levy is paid through membership with other club)
- Youth Membership: \$50 (no NZ Bridge levy)
 Criteria: Aged 23-25 and not a full-time student
- Student Membership: \$30 no NZ Bridge levy) *Criteria:* Full time students or aged under 23.
